#### THE ABSURDITIES OF DOGMA

In 1905, a 25-year-old patent clerk named Albert Einstein demolished the 200-year-old certainty that Isaac Newton knew all there was to know about basic physics. In a technical paper only a few pages long, Einstein sent a huge part of his current "reality" to history's dustbin, where it found good company with thousands of other discards large and small. In 1905, though, Newton's discard was about as large as the bin would hold.

Now another grand old "certainty" hovers over history's dustbin, and it seems only a matter of time before some new Einstein writes the few (or many) pages that will bring it down and relegate it to history. And, as was the case in 1905, every "expert" in the world laughs heartily at any suggestion that their certainty could be struck down. Yet if facts are any yardstick—which should always be the case, but frequently isn't—Charles Darwin's theory of evolution by natural selection is moving towards extinction.

Please note this: Not everyone who challenges evolution is automatically a Creationist. Darwinists love to tar all opponents with that brush because so much of Creationist dogma is absurd. Creationists mulishly exclude themselves from serious consideration by refusing to give up fatally flawed parts of their argument, such as the literal interpretation of "six days of creation". Of course, some have tried to take a more reasonable stance, but those few can't be heard over the ranting of the many who refuse.

#### [H: I must now ask the nasty question: Is "Creation" the point or is the integrity of that historical BIBLE at issue here? Ponder it!]

Recently a new group has entered the fray, much better educated than typical Creationists. This group has devised a theory called "Intelligent Design", which has a wealth of scientifically established facts on its side. The ID-ers, though, give away their Creationist roots by insisting that because life at its most basic level is so incredibly and irreducibly complex, it could never have simply "come into being" as Darwinists insist.

Actually, the "life somehow assembled itself out of organic molecules" dogma is every bit as absurd as the "everything was created in six days" dogma, which the ID-ers understand and exploit. But they also suggest that everything came into existence at the hands of God (by whatever name) or "by means of outside intervention", which makes clear how they're betting. "Outside intervention" is a transparent euphemism for "You Know What" (with apologies to J.K. Rowling). [In Rowling's "Harry Potter" books, the arch villain is so despicable and dreadful, his name should not even be uttered; thus he is referred to as "You Know Who". Similarly, the very idea that humans might have been created by extraterrestrials is so despicable and dreadful to mainstream science and religion that no mention of it should be uttered; thus the author refers to is as "You Know What". Ed.] To Darwinists, Creationists and ID-ers alike, creation at the hands of You Know What is the most absurd suggestion of all. Yet it can be shown that You Know What has the widest array of facts on its side and has the best chance of being proved correct in the end. [H: Yes, I certainly do think you need to very carefully consider this perspective.]

Virtually every scientist worth their doctorate will insist that somehow, some way, a form of evolution is at the heart of all life forms and processes on Earth. By "evolution", they mean the entire panoply of possible interpretations that might explain how, over vast stretches of time, simple organisms can and do transform themselves into more complex organisms. That broad definition gives science as a whole a great deal of room to bob and weave its way towards the truth about broadness of coverage means nobody has a withering array of internecine squabbles.

In Darwin's case, those squabbles were initially muted. Rightly or wrongly, his theory served a much higher purpose than merely processes. It provided something every scientist desperately needed: a strong counter to the intellectual nonsense pouring from pulpits in every church, synagogue and mosque in the world.

Since well before Charles Darwin was born, men of science knew full well that God did not create the Earth or anything else in the universe in six literal days. But to assert that publicly invited the same kind of censure that erupts today onto anyone who dares evolution openly. Dogma is dogma in any generation.

Yet they are, for better or worse, and those worst-case examples must be hidden or at least obscured from the general public. But no matter how often facts are twisted, data are concealed or reality is denied, the truth is out there.

#### THE EMERGENCE OF DOMESTICATED PLANTS

animals: wild and domesticated.

No botanist can conclusively explain how wild plants gave rise to domesticated ones.

There are two basic forms of plants and animals: wild and domesticated. The wild ones far outnumber the domesticated ones, which may explain why vastly more research is done on the wild forms. But it could just as easily be that scientists shy away from the domesticated ones because the things they find when examining them are so far outside the accepted evolutionary paradigm.

Nearly all domesticated plants are believed to have appeared between 10,000 and 5,000 years ago, with different groups coming to different part of the world at different times. Initially, in the so-called Fertile Crescent of modern Iraq, Syria and Lebanon, came wheat, barley and legumes, among other varieties. Later on, in the Far East, came wheat millet, rice and yams. Later still, in the New World, came maize (corn), peppers, beans, squash, tomatoes and potatoes.

Many have "wild" predecessors that were apparently a starting point for the domesticated variety, but others—like many common vegetables—have no obvious precursors. But for those that do, such as wild grasses, grains and cereals, how they turned into wheat, barley, millet, rice, etc., is a profound mystery.

No botanists can conclusively explain how wild plants gave rise to domesticated ones. The emphasis here is on "conclusively". Botanists have no trouble hypothesizing elaborate scenarios in which Neolithic (New Stone Age) farmers somehow figured out how to hybridize wild grasses, grains and cereals, not unlike Gregor Mendel when he cross-bred pea plants to figure out the mechanics of genetic inheritance. It all sounds so simple and so logical, almost no one outside scientific circles ever examines it closely.

> Gregor Mendel never bred his pea plants to be anything other than pea plants. He created short ones, tall ones and different colored ones, but they were always pea plants that produced peas. (Pea plants are a domesticated species, too, but that is irrelevant to the point to be made here.) On the other hand, those New Stone Age farmers who were fresh out of their caves and only just beginning to turn soil for the first time (as the "official" scenario goes), somehow managed to transform the wild grasses, grains and cereals growing around them into their domesticated "cousins". Is that possible? Only through a course in miracles!

Actually, it requires countless miracles within There are two basic forms of plants and two large categories of miracles. The first was that the wild grasses and grains and cereals were useless to humans. The seeds and grains were maddeningly small, like pepper flakes or salt crystals, which put them beyond the grasping and handling capacity of human fingers. They were also hard, like tiny nutshells, making it impossible to convert them to anything edible. Lastly, their chemistry was suited to nourishing animals, not humans.

> So wild varieties were entirely too small, entirely too tough and nutritionally inappropriate for humans. They needed to be greatly expanded in size, greatly softened in texture and overhauled at the molecular level—which would be an imposing challenge for modern botanists, much less Neolithic farmers.

> Despite the seeming impossibility of meeting those daunting objectives, modern botanists are confident the first sodbusters had all they needed to do it: time and patience. Over hundreds of generations of selective crossbreeding, they consciously directed the genetic transformation of the few dozen that would turn out to be most useful to humans. And how did they do it? By the astounding feat of doubling, tripling and quadrupling the number of chromosomes in the wild varieties! In a few cases, they did better than that. Domestic wheat and oats were elevated from an ancestor with seven chromosomes to their current 42—an expansion by a factor of six. Sugar cane was expanded from a 10-chromosome ancestor to the 80-chromosome monster it is today—a factor of eight. The chromosomes of others, like bananas and apples, were only multiplied by factors of two or three, while peanuts, potatoes, tobacco and cotton, among others, were expanded by factors of four. This is not as astounding as it sounds, because many wild flowering plants and trees have multiple chromosome sets.

But that brings up what Charles Darwin himself discussion on the topic of what is the difference called the "abominable mystery" of flowering plants. The first ones appear in the fossil record between 150 and 130 million years ago, primed to multiply into over 200,000 known species. > However the codes were cracked, the great expansion of genetic material in each cell of the domestic varieties caused them to grow much larger than their wild ancestors. As they grew, their seeds and grains became large enough to be easily seen and picked up and manipulated by human fingers. Simultaneously, the seeds and grains softened to a degree where they could be milled, cooked and consumed. And at the same time, their cellular chemistry was altered enough to begin providing nourishment to humans who ate them. The only word that remotely equates with that achievement is: miracle.

> Of course, "miracle" implies that there was actually a chance that such complex manipulations of Nature could be carried out by primitive yeomen in eight geographical areas over 5,000 years. This strains credulity because, in each case, in each area, someone actually had to look at a wild progenitor and imagine what it could become, or should become, or would become. Then they somehow had to ensure that their vision would be carried forward through countless generations that had to remain committed to planting, harvesting, culling and crossbreeding wild plants that put no food on their tables during their lifetimes, but which might feed their descendants in some remotely distant future.

> It is difficult to try to concoct a more unlikely, more absurd, scenario, yet to modern-day botanists it is a gospel they believe with a fervor that puts many "six day" Creationists to shame. Why? Because to confront its towering absurdity would force them to turn to You Know What for a more logical and plausible explanation.

> To domesticate a wild plant without using artificial (i.e., genetic) manipulation, it must be modified by directed crossbreeding, which is only possible through the efforts of humans. So the equation is simple. Firstly, wild ancestors for many (but not all) domestic plants do seem apparent. Secondly, most domesticated versions did appear from 10,000 to 5,000 years ago. Thirdly, the humans alive at that time were primitive barbarians. Fourthly, in the past 5,000 years, no plants have been domesticated that are nearly as valuable as the dozens that were "created" by the earliest farmers all around the world. Put an equal sign after those four factors and it definitely does not add up to any kind of Darwinian model.

Botanists know they have a serious problem here, but all they can suggest is that it simply had to have occurred by natural means because no other intervention—by God or You Know What—can be considered under any circumstances. That unwavering stance is maintained by all scientists, not just botanists, to exclude overwhelming evidence such as the fact that in 1837 the Botanical Garden in St. Petersburg, Russia, began concerned attempts to cultivate wild rye into a new form of domestication. grain or cereal (which was done time and again by our Neolithic forebears), two imposing hurdles must be cleared. These are the problems of "rachises" and "glumes", which I discuss in my book, Everything You Know is Wrong-Book One: Human Origins (pp. 283-285, Adamu Press, 1998). Glumes are botany's name for husks, the thin covers of seeds and grains that must be removed before humans can digest them. Rachises are the tiny stems that attach seeds and grains to their stalks.

strong and durable, so rain won't knock the seeds and grains off their stalks. At maturity, they become so brittle that a breeze will shatter them and release their cargo to propagate. Such a high degree of brittleness makes it impossible to harvest wild plants because every grain or seed would be knocked loose during the harvesting process.

So, in addition to enlarging, softening and nutritionally altering the seeds and grains of dozens of wild plants, the earliest farmers also had to figure out how to finely adjust the brittleness of every plant's glumes and rachises.

That adjustment was of extremely daunting complexity, perhaps more complex than the transformational process itself. The rachises had to be toughened enough to hold seeds and grains to their stalks during harvesting, yet remain brittle enough to be collected easily by human effort during what has come to be known as "threshing". Likewise, the glumes had to be made tough enough to withstand harvesting after full ripeness was achieved, yet still be brittle enough to shatter during the threshing process. And—here's the kicker—each wild plant's glumes and rachises required completely different degrees of adjustment, and the final amount of each adjustment had to be perfectly precise! In short, there is not a snowball's chance that this happened as botanists claim it did.

#### THE EMERGENCE OF DOMESTICATED ANIMALS

As with plants, animal domestication followed a pattern of development that extended 10,000 to 5,000 years ago. It also started in the Fertile Crescent, with the "big four" of cattle, sheep, goats and pigs, among other animals. Later, in the Far East, came ducks, chickens and water buffalo, among others. Later still, in the New World, came llamas and vicuna. This process was not simplified by expanding the number of chromosomes. All animals-wild and domesticated—are diploid, which means they have two sets of chromosomes, one from each parent. The number of chromosomes varies as widely as in plants (humans have 46), but there are always only two sets (human have 23 in each).

The only "tools" available to Neolithic herdsmen were those available to farming kinsmen: time and patience. By the same crossbreeding techniques apparently utilized by farmers, wild animals were selectively bred for generation after generation until enough gradual modification accumulated to create domesticated versions of wild ancestors. As with plants, this process required anywhere from hundreds to thousands of years in each case, and does. The light-colored fur on their body is like the BALDERDASH!]

Once again, we face the problem of trying to imagine those first herdsmen with enough vision to imagine a "final model", to start the breeding process during their own lifetimes and to have it carried out over centuries until the final model was achieved. This was much trickier than simply figuring out which animals had a strong pack or herding instinct that would eventually allow humans to take over as "leaders" of the herd or pack. For example, it took While growing, glumes and rachises are unbridled courage to decide to bring a wolf cub into a campsite with the intention of teaching it to kill and eat selectively and to earn its keep by barking at intruders (adult wolves rarely bark). And who could look at the massive, fearsome, ill-tempered aurochs and visualize a much smaller, much more amiable cow? Even if somebody could have visualized it, how could they have hoped to accomplish it? An auroch's calf (or a wolf cub, for that matter), carefully and lovingly raised by human "parents", would still grow up to be a full-bodied adult with hardwired adult instincts.

> However it was done, it wasn't by crossbreeding. Entire suites of genes must be modified to change the physical characteristics of animals. (In an interesting counterpoint to wild and domesticated plants, domesticated animals are usually smaller than their wild progenitors.) But with animals, something more... something ineffable... must be changed to alter their basic natures from wild to docile. To accomplish it remains beyond modern abilities, so attributing such capacity to Neolithic humans is an insult to our intelligence.

#### TAKE A LOOK ON THE WILD SIDE AT THE CHEETAH

All examples of plant and animal "domestication" incredible is the cheetah. There is no question it was one of the first tamed animals, with a history stretching back to early Egypt, India and China. As with all such examples, it could only have been created through selective breeding by Neolithic hunters, gatherers or early farmers. One of those three must get the credit.

The cheetah is the most easily tamed and trained of all the big cats. No reports are on record of a cheetah killing a human. It seems specifically created for high speeds, with an aerodynamically designed head and body. Its skeleton is lighter than other big cats; its legs are long and slim, like the legs of a greyhound. Its heart, lungs, kidneys and nasal passages are enlarged, allowing its breathing rate to jump from 60 per minute at rest to 150 bpm during a chase. Its top speed is 70 miles per hour, while a thoroughbred [horse] tops out at around 38 mph. Nothing on a savanna can outrun it. It can be outlasted, but not outrun.

Cheetahs are unique because they combine physical traits of two distinctly different animal families: dogs and cats. They belong to the family of cats, but they look like long-legged dogs. They sit and hunt like dogs. They can only partially retract their claws, like dogs instead of cats. Their paw pads are thick and hard like a dog's, but to climb trees they use the first claw on their front paws in the same way a cat

their bodies are inexplicably the texture of cat's fur. They contract diseases that only dogs suffer from, but they also get "cat only" diseases.

There is something even more inexplicable about cheetahs. Genetic tests have been done on them, and the surprising result was that in the 50 specimens tested they were all, every one, genetically identical with each other! This means the skin or internal organs of any of the thousands of cheetahs in the world could be switched with the organs of any other cheetah and not be rejected. The only other place such physical homogeneity is seen is in rats and other animals that have been genetically altered in laboratories.

(Cue the music from *The Twilight Zone...*)

Cheetahs stand apart, of course, but all domesticated animals have traits that are not explainable in terms that stand up to rigorous scientific scrutiny. Rather than deal with the embarrassment of confronting such issues, scientists studiously ignore them and, as with the mysteries of domesticated plants, explain them away as best they can. For the cheetah, they insist it simply cannot be some kind of weird genetic hybrid between cats and dogs, even though the evidence points squarely in that direction. And why? Because that, too, would move cheetahs into the forbidden zone occupied by You Know What.

The problem of the cheetahs' genetic uniformity is explained by something now known as the "bottleneck effect". What it presumes is that the wild cheetah population—which must have been as genetically diverse as its long history indicates—at some recent point in time went into a very steep population decline that left only a few breeding pairs alive. From that decimation until now, they have all shared the same restricted gene pool.

Unfortunately, there is no record of any are incredible in their own right, but perhaps the most extinction events that would selectively remove cheetahs and leave every other big cat to develop its expected genetic variation. could believe it. They had to run their samples through again and again to be certain. Even then, there was hesitancy about announcing it. > BODY HAIR. Primates need not worry about direct exposure to sunlight because they are covered from head to toe in a distinctive pattern of long body hair. Because they are quadrupeds (move on all fours), the thickest hair is on their back, the thinnest on the chest and abdomen. Humans have lost the all-over pelt, and we have completely switched our area of thickness to the chest and abdomen while wearing the thin part on our back.

FAT. Humans have ten times as many fat cells attached to the underside of their skin as primates. If a primate is wounded by a gash or tear in the skin, when the bleeding stops the wound's edges lie flat near each other and can quickly close the wound by a process called "contracture". In humans, the fat layer is so thick that it pushes up through wounds and makes contraction difficult if not impossible. Also, contrary to the propaganda to try to explain this oddity, know-it-alls at the back of a classroom, desperate to the fat under human skin does not compensate for the

body hair we have lost. Only in water is its insulating capacity useful; in air, it is minimal at best.

HEAD HAIR. All primates have head hair that grows to a certain length and then stops. Human head hair grows to such lengths that it could be dangerous in a primitive situation. Thus, we have been forced to cut our head hair since we became a species, which may account for some of the sharp flakes of stones that are considered primitive hominid "tools".

FINGERNAILS AND TOENAILS. primates have fingernails and toenails that grow to a certain length and then stop, never needing paring. Human fingernails and toenails have always needed paring. Again, maybe those stone "tools" were not only for butchering animals.

SKULLS. The human skull is nothing like the primate skull. There is hardly any fair morphological comparison to be made, apart from the general parts being the same. Their design and assembly are so radically different as to make attempts at comparison useless.

BRAINS. The comparison here is even more radical because human brains are so vastly different. (To say "improved" or "superior" is unfair and not germane, because primate brains work perfectly well for what primates have to do to live and reproduce.)

LOCOMOTION. The comparison here is easily as wide as the comparison of brains and skulls. Humans are bipedal; primates are quadrupeds. That says more than enough.

SPEECH. Human throats are completely redesigned relative to primate throats. The larynx has dropped to a much lower position, so humans can break typical primate sounds into the tiny pieces of sound (by modulation) that have come to be human speech.

SEX. Primate females have estrous cycles and are sexually receptive only at special times. Human They are continually receptive to sex. (Unless, of course, they have the proverbial headache!)

This is the most CHROMOSOMES. inexplicable difference of all. Primates have 48 chromosomes. Humans are considered vastly superior to them in a wide array of areas, yet somehow we have only 46 chromosomes! This begs the question of how we could lose two full chromosomes—which represents a lot of DNA—in the first place, and in the process become so much better. Nothing about it makes logical sense.

GENETIC DISORDERS. As with all wild animals (plants, too), primates have relatively few genetic disorders spread throughout their gene pools. Albinism is one that is common to many animal groups as well as humans. But albinism does not stop an animal with it from growing up and passing the gene for it into the gene pool. Mostly, though, serious defects are quickly weeded out in the wild. Often, parents or others in a group will do the job swiftly and surely, so wild gene pools stay relatively clear. In contrast, humans have over 4,000 genetic disorders, and several of those will absolutely kill every victim before reproduction is possible. This begs the question of how such defects could possibly get into the human gene pool in the first place, much less how they remain so widespread.

GENETIC RELATEDNESS. Darwinist statistic is that the total genome (all the DNA) of humans differs from chimpanzees by only 1% and from gorillas by 2%. This makes it seem as if evolution is indeed correct and that humans and doesn't mean she's not suiting up. primates are virtually kissing cousins. Syndicate led by sultan plans to cut off victim's thumb, transplant it to impostor

SIX heavily-armed men reportedly tried to abduct a prince claiming to be the owner of the entire archipelago in front of a fastfood chain last month in Quezon City.

This was revealed to *People's Tonight* by Pablo Aquino, Jr., attorney-in-fact of "Prince" Julian Morden Tallano who added that the attempted abduction was reported to the Baler Police station of the Central Police District.

Tallano claims to be a descendant of a certain King Luisong Tagean, whose sons include Rajah Soliman and Lapu-lapu. He has been declared by the suing others. Now to return to the article.]

From time to time come articles in the local press Pasay City Regional Trial Court to be the lawful owner of the entire Philippine archipelago or to properties Readers of CONTACT already know about Prince consisting of 169,912,500 hectares (373,807,500 acres) or more than 16 billion square meters of territory including plains, mountains, forests and seas.

> In a statement, Tallano, now in his 50s, said the incident occurred on the night of June 4 while he was waiting for his driver, Lito Dulay, in front of a McDonald's hamburger joint on Munoz, EDSA, QC.

Tallano said a green F150 Ford (plate no. WNC-155) with six armed men on board arrived and inquired about his whereabouts from Dulay. The "prince" added that he heard the suspects' plan of abducting and killing him while he was hiding inside the car of a certain Rolly Mallo.

Dulay allegedly failed to give information on van and take the Mercedes Benz owned by Tallano. Mallo and the Mercedes Benz are still missing.

[Let us summarize the picture. Tallano and his July 7, 2002 in the same paper as before, driver, Dulay, have parked their Mercedes in front of a McDonald's. Tallano is hiding close by in Mallo's car where he can overhear the threats made by the six heavily-armed men but he is not found. The six grab Dulay and drag him into their van and make off with the Tallano Mercedes and Mallo, both of which are still missing. How about Dulay?

> [This is a typical Philippine Drama, told with child-like innocence with complete confidence that it will be believed. The really sick part of this one, however, is that it appears to be a complete, from the ground up, fabrication on the part of attorneys used a scheme to sell properties from his "master deeds" without his knowledge, and without his being paid anything. This "scare" story is apparently to keep him "underground" and from showing his face in court where he might learn what is going on because among the court documents that have been unearthed is a list of 31 cases, some against Tallano and some wherein Tallano (or someone with a power of attorney) is

Tallano's group believes a syndicate led by a sultan could have planned to cut off Tallano's right thumb and transplant it to an impostor. If the plan succeeded, the fake prince would be able to authenticate sales documents, deeds of conveyance as well as papers granting special powers of attorney.

In a press statement, Philippine National Police retired Ben. Braulio Monge, Sr. confirmed the real Tallano is exposed to imminent danger.

Aquino said that Tallano has nothing to do with the syndicate who harassed, threatened and coerced legitimate owners of titled properties, specially those who own vacant lots in Metro Manila. Tallano has warned the public to observe precaution from dealings with spurious attorneys-in-fact and representatives claiming to be authorized representatives of the Tallano (Tala) Estate.

Aquino said members of the syndicate could be the former attorneys-in-fact of Tallano whose functions have been cancelled, terminated and declared null and void due to loss of trust and confidence.

The office of Quezon City Mayor Feliciano Belmonte Tallano, promoting the suspects to drag him into their Jr., had been receiving numerous complaints on syndicate members who have been trying to take over vacant lots on the basis of Transfer of Certificate of Titles.

> Tallano's claim of ownership over the entire Philippines is pending before the Court of Appeals. Earlier, the Office of the Solicitor General sought the annulment of judgment with urgent prayer for issuance of temporary restraining order and writ of preliminary injunction. Last year the Pasay City RTC reconstituted the case which eventually became final and executory in July 2001. [End Quoting]

> As a bit of a postscript: Two weeks ago when we were setting up a meeting for Tallano and a group of "titled" Muslims from Zamboanga City, including a 10year-old boy purported to be the proper heir to the throne of the Sultan of Sulu, the "current" attorney of Tallano, Vic Miraflor, called to inquire if a certain "Sultan Torres" from Baguio (which is north of here and not in Muslim country) had been invited. I said, "Come on, Vic, who ever heard of a Sultan named Torres? That's about as bad as the guy who came here claiming his name was Datu Lim." [The Spanish and Chinese are both abhorred by the Muslims. Datu is, properly, a designation of "Royal" Muslim lineage; Lim is, of course, very Chinese.]

> Please notice in the sub-headline above that "led by sultan" appears. That is, of course, a reference to "Torres" which has been dropped by the Drama-makers since, later in the article it says, "Aquino said members of the syndicate could be the former attorneys-in-fact...".

She grabbed her binoculars and watched the destruction unfolding in lower Manhattan. But as she watched the disaster, something else caught her eye.

Maria says she saw three young men kneeling on the building. "They seemed to be taking a movie," Maria said.

The men were taking video or photos of themselves with the World Trade Center burning in the background, she said. What struck Maria were the expressions on the men's faces. "They were like happy, you know... They didn't look shocked to me. I thought it was very strange," she said.

She found the behavior so suspicious that she wrote down the license plate number of the van and called the statewide bulletin was issued on the van.

The plate number was traced to a van owned by a company called Urban Moving. Around 4 p.m. on Sept. 11, the van was spotted on a service road off Route 3, near New Jersey's Giants Stadium. A police officer pulled the van over, finding five men, between 22 and 27 years old, in the vehicle. The men were taken out of the van at gunpoint and handcuffed by police.

The arresting officers said they saw a lot that aroused their suspicion about the men. One of the passengers had \$4,700 in cash hidden in his sock. Another was carrying two foreign passports. A box cutter was found in the van. But perhaps the biggest surprise for the officers came when the five men identified themselves as Israeli citizens.

According to the police report, one of the passengers told the officers they had been on the West Side Highway in Manhattan "during the incident"-referring to the World Trade Center attack. The driver of the van, Sivan Kurzberg, told the officers, "We are Israeli. We are not your problem. Your problems are our problems. The Palestinians are the problem." The other passengers were his brother Paul Kurzberg, Yaron Shmuel, Oded Ellner and Omer Marmari.

When the men were transferred to jail, the case was transferred out of the FBI's Criminal Division, and into the bureau's Foreign Counterintelligence Section, which is responsible for espionage cases, ABCNEWS has learned.

One reason for the shift, sources told ABCNEWS, was that the FBI believed Urban Moving may have been providing cover for an Israeli intelligence operation.

After the five men were arrested, the FBI got a warrant and searched Urban Moving's Weehawken, N.J., offices.

The FBI searched Urban Moving's offices for several hours, removing boxes of documents and a dozen computer hard drives. The FBI also questioned Urban Moving's owner. His attorney insists that his client answered all of Israeli intelligence out of the New Jersey moving the FBI's questions. But when FBI agents tried to interview him again a few days later, he was gone.

Three months later 2020's cameras photographed the inside of Urban Moving, and it looked as if the business had been shut down in a big hurry. Cell phones were lying around; office phones were still connected; and the

property of dozens of clients remained in the warehouse.

The owner had also cleared out of his New Jersey home, put it up for sale and returned with his family to Israel.

Steven Gordon, the attorney for the five Israeli detainees, acknowledged that his clients' actions on Sept. 11 would easily have aroused suspicions. "You got a group of guys that are taking pictures, on top of a roof, of the World Trade Center. They're speaking in a foreign language. They got two passports on 'em. One's got a wad of cash on him, and they got box cutters. Now that's a scary situation."

But Gordon insisted that his clients were just five roof of a white van in the parking lot of her apartment young men who had come to America for a vacation, ended up working for a moving company, and were taking pictures of the event.

The five Israelis were held at the Metropolitan Detention Center in Brooklyn, ostensibly for overstaying their tourist visas and working in the United States illegally. Two weeks after their arrest, an immigration judge ordered them to be deported. But sources told ABCNEWS that FBI and CIA officials in Washington put a hold on the case.

The five men were held in detention for more than police. Before long, the FBI was also on the scene, and a two months. Some of them were placed in solitary confinement for 40 days, and some of them were given as many as seven lie-detector tests.

> Sources say the Israelis were targeting these fundraising networks because they were thought to be channeling money to Hamas and Islamic Jihad, groups that are responsible for most of the suicide bombings in Israel. #### HAMAS HISTORY TIED TO ISRAEL

In the wake of a suicide bomb attack Tuesday on a crowded Jerusalem city bus that killed 19 people and wounded at least 70 more, the Islamic Resistance Movement, Hamas, took credit for the blast. Israeli officials called it the deadliest attack in Jerusalem in six years.

Israeli Prime Minister Ariel Sharon immediately vowed to fight "Palestinian terror" and summoned his cabinet to decide on a military response to the organization that Sharon had once described as "the deadliest terrorist group that we have ever had to face".

Active in Gaza and the West Bank, Hamas wants to liberate all of Palestine and establish a radical Islamic state in place of Israel. It has gained notoriety with its assassinations, car bombs and other acts of terrorism. But Sharon left something out.

Israel and Hamas may currently be locked in deadly combat, but, according to several current and former U.S. intelligence officials, beginning in the late 1970s, Tel Aviv gave direct and indirect financial aid to Hamas over a period of years.

Israel "aided Hamas directly - the Israelis wanted to use it as a counterbalance to the PLO (Palestinian Liberation Organization)," said Tony Cordesman, Middle East analyst for the Center for Strategic Studies. Israel's support for Hamas "was a direct attempt to divide and dilute support for a strong, secular PLO by using a competing religious alternative," said a former senior CIA official.

Hamas immediately grew in numbers and violence.

#### SOME GERMANS CLAMOR FOR RECOGNITION AS VICTIMS

BERLIN-From the unsettled memories of Adolf Union. An additional 100,000 have registered for visas and Hitler's defeat in World War II, Germans are resurrecting a controversial group of war victims: themselves.

> In the chaos following the Third Reich's collapse in 1945, more than 13 million Germans were expelled from lands where they had lived for centuries. About 7 million lost their homes when Poland's borders shifted west. An additional 3 million Sudeten Germans were evicted from what was then Czechoslovakia. Others were pushed out of traditional German settlements along the Danube River in Yugoslavia and Hungary.

Tens of thousands of people died in the process, but Germany was markedly different from the progressive, little was said of them. Germany, after all, was the aggressor well-assimilated community of German Jews that was in the war and the perpetrator of the Holocaust. The mantle of its own guilt lay heavily on its postwar consciousness.

Outside Germany, there was a sense that whatever Germans may have suffered, they were the architects of their own misery.

In Germany, however, the stories of these Germans are now being looked at in a different light. In his latest novel, Gunter Grass, the Nobel laureate and conscience of postwar Germany, re-creates the deaths of 8,000 German civilians on a ship torpedoed by a Russian submarine as it attempted to flee the port of Danzig, Grass' birthplace, which is now the Polish city of Gdansk.

Crab Walk, published earlier this year to critical acclaim, has opened a door that many others not of Grass' stature appear eager to shoulder through.

Among them is Joerg Haider of Austria's far-right Freedom Party, who has lately championed the cause of the Sudeten Germans. Palestinian Authority President Yasir Arafat stunned the world yesterday by demanding that the United States hold democratic elections for a new Chief Executive before it attempts to continue in its role as broker between Israel and Palestine.

"Mr. Bush is tainted by his association with Jim-Crowstyle selective disenfranchisement and executive strong-arm tactics in a southeastern province controlled by his brother," said Mr. Arafat, who was elected with 87% of the vote in 1996 elections in the West Bank and Gaza, declared to be free and fair by international observers, including former U.S. president Jimmy Carter. "After it was over and I was back in power," said Chavez, "his administration actually told me 'legitimacy is not conferred by a majority vote.' #### **G-8 SUMMIT SIDELINES AFRICA**

The leaders of four African countries and United Nations Secretary-General Kofi Annan attended the second day of the summit to press G-8 leaders to support the New Partnership for African Development (NEPAD). The homegrown Marshall Plan calls for aid and greater market access from the G-8 in exchange for a "peer review" system in which the African countries themselves would decide who is entitled to G-8 money—based on how well a nation protects foreign investors and human rights.

As both summit delegates and activists point out, African nations face problems of epidemic proportions. One-half of the continent's population of 680 million people live on an income of less than \$1 per day. More than 12 million have died in wars in the past decade. More than 25 million have AIDS, and 2.4 million died of the disease last year. One hundred and forty children out of every 1,000 don't live to see their fifth birthday.

But Africans hoping for a firm international commitment from the G-8 received a slap in the face delivered principally by George W. Bush. Bush essentially steered the agenda at the summit away from Africa, focusing instead on drumming up support for his new Mideast peace plan and the war on terrorism. At the start of the summit, Bush congratulated himself for already earmarking \$500 million for AIDS programs and \$200 million for Third-World education. (The two-day G-8 summit itself cost \$200 million, much of it spent on policing the modest anti-globalization protests that took place in downtown Calgary.) Africa was clearly not a priority for the U.S. at the summit.

In the end, African nations got little of what they

Although the G-8 leaders endorsed NEPAD, they week's summit will be distributed over several years. refused to spend the \$64 billion the plan requires. They instead announced their own "Action Plan for reach those levels of assistance," he said. Bush's insistence, they earmarked \$20 billion for a program to prevent Russian nuclear weapons from falling into terrorist hands. At the final press conference, the African delegates tried to put a positive spin on the G-8 meetings, calling them a "starting point". "We are satisfied with this commitment. Of course, there is nothing that is human that is perfect," said Nigerian president Olusegun Obasanjo.

The NGOs and civil society groups who came to monitor the summit were more vocal in their disappointment, accusing the G-8 nations of double-standards. Amnesty International pointed out that although the G-8 announced that it would only provide future aid to countries protecting human rights, G-8 nations sell more than \$25 billion in arms to developing countries every year (the U.S. is the largest exporter at \$14 billion annually).

An economic-justice group based in Washington, D.C., called 50 Years is Enough noted that the G-8 insist (through the World Bank) that African countries eliminate all their agricultural subsidies even though the G-8 themselves have given \$500 billion in subsidies to their own farmers this year alone. Activists say such policies have had a dramatic impact on countries which rely on a few agricultural crops. Twenty years ago, for example, Ghana subsidized its farmers and exported rice; now it imports \$150 million of the grain every year, mainly from the United States. To many of these critics, NEPAD would be no saving grace, even if it were fully funded.

NEPAD—"knee pad", as skeptics pronounce it countries, without any public consultation. The G-8 endorsed NEPAD mainly because it speaks the language they want to hear, making Africa more responsible for its own fate, expanding the free-trade "structural creating new opportunities for "investment".

In practice, however, these policies often entail little more than the sale of public utilities. The World Bank, for example, now requires African countries to privatize their water systems in order to qualify for loans, even though water is still a public utility in G-8 countries. "It's a way to entice African governments to be the agents of their own destruction," said Njoki Njoroge Njehu, a spokeswoman for 50 Years is Enough. "For the purposes of multinational corporations, for new frontiers to make profits, NEPAD is a gift."

More importantly, say activists, both NEPAD and the G-8 Action Plan refuse to deal with pressing problems facing Africa—problems that may prevent any kind of development either now or in the future. Although the G-8 leaders announced \$1 billion in new debt relief this week, African nations still send more money to G-8 bankers to service their debts every year than they receive in aid. The debt drains what little funds they have for health care and education.

Worse still, almost no new money was set aside to fight AIDS.

In an impassioned speech at a counter-summit held here, Stephen Lewis, the UN Special Envoy on AIDS in Africa, insisted that NEPAD's noble aim of cutting African poverty in half by 2015 will be impossible "when family income is gutted as wage earners die, as plots of land are left untended, as every penny goes to the care of the sick and the dying."

#### U.S. PLANS ADDITIONAL PHILIPPINE MILITARY TRAINING

WASHINGTON—U.S. troops will train two more Filipino special forces units and instruct an additional eight regular infantry battalions under a new security assistance plan worked out in recent days, Pentagon officials said.

The plan represents the next phase in a heightened U.S. effort to improve the capabilities of the Philippine military. The Pentagon has used the Bush administration's "war on terrorism" as a timely rationale for intensifying military ties with the Philippines, arguing that the presence of rebel and criminal groups throughout Southeast Asia offers an inviting haven for international terrorists.

Enlisting nearly 1,300 U.S. troops, the current effort has grown into the war's largest deployment outside Central Asia. Concentrated on the southern island of Basilan, the U.S. initiative has provided counterterrorism training aimed at wiping out the ragtag militant Muslim group Abu Sayyaf.

But the initial assistance that the United States offered is due to end July 31. A Pentagon official who provided details of the next phase of U.S. involvement said it would include substantially fewer U.S. troops and avoid targeting a specific enemy. Instead of focusing on a particular island, the official added, the new training will be directed at Philippine troops spread among several locations.

About 900 U.S. troops will be withdrawn shortly after the current program ends, the official said, and by October fewer than 100 will remain. Most of those will comprise a liaison group in Zamboanga on the southern island of Mindanao, where the Philippine military maintains a regional headquarters.

In the coming year, U.S. military instructors are slated to return to train two Light Reaction troops trained one such Philippine unit in early 2001, and the new instruction will be conducted at the same place: Ft. Magsaysay on the northern island of Luzon.

Additionally, plans call for U.S. troops to train eight regular infantry battalions on Mindanao and provide night-flying instruction to helicopter pilots operating out of the Visayas islands in the central Philippines.

But unlike the training on Basilan, which has culminated with U.S. military advisers going out on jungle patrols with Philippine troops, the follow-up program will consist largely of classroom instruction and basic skill courses.

"We're making a significant switch from on-the-job training to classroom instruction," the official said. "There are no plans right now to do any lower-level field training." #### FBI BEGINS VISITING LIBRARIES

WASHINGTON (AP)—The FBI is visiting libraries suspects of having ties to terrorists or plotting an attack, library officials say.

The FBI effort, authorized by the antiterrorism law enacted after the Sept. 11 attacks, is the first broad government check of library records since the 1970s when government efforts to obtain records. prosecutors reined in the practice for fear of abuses.

Libraries across the nation were reluctant to discuss their dealings with the FBI. The same law Mahathir told a meeting of the Thai-Malaysia that makes the searches legal also makes it a criminal offense for librarians to reveal the details or extent.

In Florida, Broward County library director Sam Morrison said the FBI had recently contacted his office. He declined to elaborate on the request or how many branch libraries were involved.

"We've heard from them and that's all I can tell you," Morrison said. He said the FBI specifically instructed him not to reveal any information about the request.

The library system has been contacted before. A week after the Sept. 11 attacks, the FBI subpoenaed Morrison to provide information on the possible use of computer terminals by some of the suspected hijackers in the Hollywood, Fla., area.

In October, investigators revisited the county's main library in Fort Lauderdale and also checked a regional library in Coral Springs.

At least 15 of the 19 hijackers had Florida connections. The process by which the FBI gains access to library records is quick and mostly secret under the Patriot Act.

First, the FBI must obtain a search warrant from a court that meets in secret to hear the agency's case. The FBI must show it has reason to suspect that a person is involved with a terrorist or a terrorist plot—far less difficult than meeting the tougher legal standards of probable cause, required for traditional search warrants or reasonable doubt, required for convictions.

With the warrant, FBI investigators can visit a library and gain immediate access to the records.

Judith Krug, the American Library Association's director for intellectual freedom, said the FBI was treading on the rights it is supposed to be upholding.

"It's unfortunate because these records and this information can be had with so little reason or explanation," Krug said. "It's super secret and anyone who wants to talk about what the FBI did at their library faces prosecution. That has nothing to do with patriotism."

Krug tells worried librarians who call that they should keep only the records they need and should discard records that would reveal which patron checked out a book and for how long.

She is frustrated by the hate mail she says she receives when she speaks out against the Patriot Act.

"People are scared and they think that by giving nationwide and checking the reading records of people it up their rights, especially their right to privacy, they will be safe," Krug said. "But it wasn't the right to privacy that let terrorists into our nation. It had nothing to do with libraries or library records."

Some libraries said they will still resist

#### PLUNGE PROTECTION

It has become fashionable to point the finger at something called the Plunge Protection Team (PPT) whenever the stock market suddenly reverses higher or fails to collapse in response to bad news. The PPT, which does actually exist although its proper name is the Working Group on Financial Markets, is headed by the Secretary of the Treasury and counts the Fed chairman as one of its members. The theory is that the PPT acts to prevent large declines in the stock market by buying S&P500 futures at critical times.

Manipulation happens in the stock market on a daily basis. Mutual funds, specialists, hedge funds, Wall Street firms and large speculators are often deliberately trying to move prices in one direction or another. This manipulation does not alter the trend, but it can affect the path the market takes to get from point A to point B. Furthermore, we know that the U. S. Government intervenes in the currency and bond markets and we can be pretty sure that it meddles in the gold market, so it is not much of a stretch to conclude that the Fed and the Treasury are also directly involved in stock market manipulation. This is particularly so since it was revealed earlier this year that the Fed contemplated "unconventional measures" to stabilise markets.

Further to the above, it is not difficult to believe that the PPT would intervene in the stock market. However, we have seen absolutely no evidence that such intervention has occurred. In our view, those who are pointing fingers at the PPT are misreading the market?

Trading would be very simple if we could make money by just buying in response to good news and selling in response to bad news. Unfortunately, markets don't work that way. All of the financial markets will regularly do the opposite of what you expect if your expectation is shaped by the 'news of the day'.

During the devastating stock bear market of 1974 the market would often rally in the wake of bad news. In fact, the news at that time was generally MUCH worse than any of the recent news while the upward reversals following the bad news tended to be more pronounced than the upward reversals we have seen over the past few months. There was no PPT in existence in the 1970s and, as such, no 'they' to blame for the rallies that occurred in the face of the deteriorating fundamentals.

As is the case now, the major stock indices were immersed in powerful downtrends during 1974 and each upward reversal was followed by a decline to new lows until the final capitulation occurred. In 1974 the final decline major bottom was reached about 2 months later.

The PPT has enormous power and if it chose to make full use of that power it could certainly push the stock not outgrow the contributions that are made by [JR: With the passage of this all-encompassing USA indices considerably higher. The Fed, a member of the PPT, Patriot Act, it is most difficult for anyone to comply with has an unlimited ability to create dollars, so if it really wanted to the Fed could print enough currency tomorrow Constitution. The FBI obtains search warrants without to buy the entire stock market. (There is, of course, a practical limitation to the Fed's currency-creating ability in that the more dollars it prints the weaker the U.S. dollar would become.) From what we've observed the PPT has not, to date, chosen to make direct use of its immense power as far as stock market support is concerned. For example, when the stock exchanges opened for business last year following the September terrorist attacks the market plunged for 5 straight days. The decline didn't end until a) the market had become more oversold than it had been at any time over the past 40 years, b) the small traders had capitulated and the commercial traders had covered a substantial part of their short position, and c) the S&P500 had dropped to within 10 points of major support as defined by the 1998 low. From such a position it would have been amazing if the market had not been able to mount a sizeable rally.

> If ever there was a time that the PPT could have justified an intervention the period of September 17-21 last year was it, but it looks as though the market was allowed to fall until a massive oversold recoil became inevitable. There was, of course, indirect intervention in the form of interest rate cuts and money-supply expansion, an effect of which, as we noted at the time, would be higher gold and commodity prices in the months and years to follow.

As far as last week's action is concerned, there seems to be widespread surprise that the market was able to recover in the wake of the Worldcom news. However, was the market's performance following this news really so difficult to comprehend that unnatural forces become the most probable cause of this performance?

Prior to the reporting of the \$3.6B 'mistake' in Worldcom's books the WCOM stock price had already fallen by more than 98% from its all-time high. In fact, WCOM's market cap, just prior to last week's news, made no sense if the results that had previously been reported by the company represented its true financial situation. The stock was way too cheap. Clearly, the specifics of Worldcom's creative bookkeeping came as a surprise but the market already knew, prior to the news, that something was horribly wrong at that company. It just didn't know the details.

The market (the S&P500 Index) is trending down and we expect this trend to persist until the majority of stocks have become fundamentally under-valued. However, within this downtrend there will be counter-trend rallies and there will be many occasions on which the market reverses higher following bad news. This is normal and is what the market must do if it is to maintain some semblance of hope (hope is what bear markets feed on). The final bottom could come quickly as a result of mutual fund investors giving-up en masse (perhaps in response to some devastating and truly unexpected news), or it could come slowly following a drawn-out slide (a death by a thousand cuts).

If there were no Fed, other countries would not need a central bank of their own to finance the accumulation of dollar reserves so that they can trade and sustain the U.S.-dependent global economy (or inflation scheme).

If there were no Fed, the same nations might finally be persuaded to legislate private property rights as a means to achieve the same ends they only think they are today.

If there were no Fed, OPEC wouldn't need to exist to protect its monetary interests, and the world might never run out of oil.

If there were no Fed, we wouldn't have to save the stock market to keep the country from going to war, or from being fully employed.

If there were no Fed, the individual's word might be as good as gold, in business or in politics. Maybe even in law (joking here).

That's fifteen benefits the Fed interferes with and there are more, but time is limited.

I can think of no convincing justification for the existence of a central bank except for in its role as lender of last resort. But I can think of no compelling reason that would necessitate a lender of last resort, save where monetary policies or lending becomes profligate.

Sure, some believe markets are inherently unstable. We disagree, and propose that those claiming so have helped to justify the Fed. How does a lender of last resort ply its trade? Does it have an inexhaustible source of funds? It does, in our collective ignorance.

Nearly every time the Fed whisks its safety net onto the economy it leads to a new financial boom. Hmmm. I wonder what we should make of that?

I'll tell you what I think. Those condemning the market for its instability, completely disregarding the Fed's influence in this drama, provide the main support for the Fed's charter, and they may even benefit from the volatility or wealth transfer. ...

Think about that quote the next time there is may not need to depend on foreign savings at all. only logical after all. Did I say that out loud...

#### The Greenspan Horse

A central bank can in theory act in the capacity of a gold standard (using the term loosely), but then why would we need the central bank at all? Well for one, a central bank that claims to be acting in such a capacity is asserting its superiority to gold-as-money. It claims to be better. It may or may not see gold as its natural enemy. In a perfect world it could even be an ally. But the central bank that does not strive to better gold-asmoney must by definition be its enemy, if gold is in fact the better money. Else, how else could it survive?

Some people may need to beat up on other people to feel better about themselves. If gold is the better money, a central bank's survival would depend on its ability to either demonstrate its superiority, or to beat up on gold. If it chooses to employ the latter, it is no longer simply an opponent of gold. It becomes an enemy of money, and thus by extension, to capitalism.

If a central bank refutes the principles of sound money should we be surprised it is in support of too much of it? Should we be surprised at the legitimacy of terms such as elastic money, fractional reserve lending, or that growth requires more money?

Money doesn't breed greed and corruption by itself. Too much money does. It also breeds malinvestment. It should be no surprise who is ultimately responsible for that. It is the same institution we all are most afraid to banish. It is the institution whose currency we are trained to need. ...

Mises spent the next page or two doing so—by summarizing the illegitimacy of this concept—and also devoted several hundred pages to it along with the many other banking theories of the day. The point is that many of today's popular generalist economic doctrines have already been scientifically rejected at least 75 years ago. It's just that most people are too lazy to know it. I hate that conclusion just as much as you may, but it's true.

Ignorance is not bliss. On the contrary, our leaders count on it.

Federal Reserve Chairman Greenspan is not ignorant. He was, or is a student of von Mises', and it is more than likely his mastery of the subject is what makes him such a worthy opponent to gold, capitalism, and money. Who better to take charge of the agents of inflation than one who knows why gold is consistently the better money?

A central bank is to capitalism what the Trojan horse was to the mythological city of Troy. It's not a safety net, but rather a tool for plunder. It's certainly not a gift, but then, neither was the big wooden horse. ...

There is no end to the ways the money supply can be persuaded to grow. It is true that we can't really push on a string. But the string analogy doesn't apply in the new economy. The reason is there are many strings and some of them are designed to pull along the value of certain assets, and thus push (influence) the demand for new currency.

The "money" supply is an important gauge to the extent too much of it undermines the prevailing system of production, for it's the efficacy of that system which ultimately determines demand for the currency. The current state of the system of production is such that it has been corrupted by too much currency. And more of it isn't going to make it all better.

Productivity can't save a society or system corrupted by easy money any more than it could've helped the city of Troy defend itself against the quiet army hidden in the belly of the wooden horse.

# Maintaining Privacy Of Corporate Records

Budget's "Tip of the Week" #2:

NRS 78.257—Right of stockholders to inspect and audit financial records; exceptions

Last week we discussed NRS 78.105 and how it appears to have been written specifically to provide access to the corporation's records by the corporation's stockholders. What about a case where the stockholder's interest in accessing the records has nothing to do with the stockholder's interest in the corporation? And what about other parties who might want to access the corporation's private records? NRS 78.257 holds the answer to those questions, though the answers are, no doubt, NOT what such parties might wish to hear!

After defining who is entitled to inspect the corporate records and the notice that must be given for doing so in paragraph 1, then specifying that the inspecting party bears the costs of extracting such in paragraph 2, NRS 78.257, paragraph 3, states (emphasis added):

3. The rights authorized by subsection 1 may be denied to any stockholder upon his refusal to furnish the corporation an affidavit that such inspection, extracts or audit is not desired for any purpose not related to his interest in the corporation as a stockholder. Any stockholder or other person, exercising rights under subsection 1, who uses or attempts to use information, documents, records or other data obtained from the corporation, for any purpose not related to the stockholder's interest in the corporation as a stockholder, is guilty of a gross misdemeanor. ...

A gross misdemeanor conviction is punishable by incarceration for up to one year in the county jail and a \$2,000 fine. Note that this statute spells out rights of the *stockholders* to inspect corporate records—the *stockholders*, not "just anyone". There is no mandate of any kind for non-stockholders to ever inspect any corporate records. It is a gross misdemeanor for any non-stockholder to even attempt to use information from the corporate records in any way contrary to the interests of the stockholders.

Next week, we'll look at a method of owning a corporation without owning its stock—and yes, the answer to that riddle can also be found built right into the *Nevada Revised Statutes*!

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
